- At the outset Prof. JVR Ravindra, Principal & Chairman of IQAC welcomed the members to the meeting and introduced the external members of the Committee.

Introduction of External Members of the IQAC Committee:

- The meeting commenced with the introduction of the esteemed external members of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Committee by Prof. JVR Ravindra, Principal and Chairman of the IQAC. The members introduced included Prof. Prashant R. Nair (Head of IQAC), Prof. R. Nageswara Rao (Director, IQAC, O.U. and Professor of Finance & IT), Mr. Jitender Singh (HR Manager, Cognizant), Mr. Gerard Jaysingh (Head Offshore Delivery, E-AppSys Ltd), Prof. Suresh Purini (Associate Professor at IIIT Hyderabad), and Mr. G. Naveen Kumar (IES Officer at Indian Railways). Their diverse expertise and experience are expected to significantly contribute to the enhancement of educational quality and institutional effectiveness.

Reconstitution of IQAC Members:

- Prof. JVR Ravindra also presented the reconstitution of the IQAC, which now includes a total of 21 members. He will continue to serve as the Chairman, with Dr. E.R. Aruna maintaining her role as the IQAC Coordinator. The internal members, representing various departments of Vardhaman College, ensure broad expertise, while the inclusion of new external members brings diverse perspectives, further strengthening the institution's quality assurance initiatives.

Principal briefed the Institute (Management, Vision, Mission, Quality Policy, institute awards and accolades, programs offered, infrastructure).

Vision and Mission:

- During the meeting, Prof. JVR Ravindra emphasized the vision and mission of Vardhaman College of Engineering, Hyderabad, underscoring the commitment to fostering a culture of continuous improvement and educational excellence.

Programs Offered:

- He also highlighted the wide range of programs offered by Vardhaman College, including Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech), Master of Technology (M.Tech), Master of Business Administration (MBA), and Doctoral programs. These programs reflect the institution's commitment to providing comprehensive educational opportunities that cater to the diverse needs and aspirations of students.

Approvals and Affiliations: Prof. JVR Ravindra outlined the key approvals and affiliations of Vardhaman College, which include

- Approval by the All-India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi.
- Status as a UGC Autonomous College.
- Permanent affiliation with Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH), Hyderabad. These recognitions underscore the institution's commitment to maintaining high standards in education and fostering academic excellence.

Awards and Accolades: Furthermore, Prof. JVR Ravindra presented the significant awards received by Vardhaman College, which include

- Accreditation by NAAC with an 'A++' Grade.
- Six UG programs accredited by NBA, New Delhi, under Tier-1.
- Accreditation of the Department of Management Studies' PG program by NBA.
- Approval by UGC under Section 2(f) and 12(B).
- Identification as a College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) by UGC.
- Ranking in the 151-200 band in the Engineering category in the NIRF 2023 Rankings.
- Achieving Band 51-100 in the NIRF Innovation Category in 2023.
- Identification as an AICTE-MIC funded Mentor Institute for 2023-2024 under IIC 6.0.
- A 4-Star Rating from IIC-MoE, Govt for developing an innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem on campus in 2021.
- Designation as a Research Centre under JNTUH, Hyderabad.
- Designation as a Science and Industrial Research Organization by DSIR.
- Designation as AICTE Margadarshan and AICTE UBA Institute.
- Certification as an ISO 9001:2015 Certified Institute.
- Designation as an Incubation Center by Startup India.
- Award as the Most Promising Engineering College in Educational Excellence by Times. These accolades reflect Vardhaman College's dedication to academic excellence, innovation, and research development.

IQAC Chairman welcomed Coordinator IQAC to continue the remaining agenda items.

Dr. E.R. Aruna, IQAC Coordinator took over the rest of the presentation and she started with stating the vision and mission of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

Vision and Mission:

- The vision and mission of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) were emphasized during the meeting, highlighting the commitment to fostering a culture of continuous improvement and excellence in education.
- She continued to present the quality initiatives and Action taken report for the year 2023-24, outlining the strategic plans and programs aimed at enhancing the academic and administrative standards of the institution.

IQAC Quality Initiatives and Action Taken Report – 2023-2024

Quality Benchmarks:

- The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has implemented quality Departmental Benchmarks, Departmental Scorecards (DSC) and exemplary awards achieved by Departments in the past three years. She presented the Performance-Based Appraisal System (PBAS) based on Academic performance indicators (API) including teaching, learning and evaluation, research publications, Extension activities and professional development as faculty benchmarks.

Best Practices:

- Dr. E. R. Aruna highlighted best practices that were established over the past 5 years. Collaborations, including Gyan Ganga, startups, innovations, and active participation in professional societies are to name a few.

Accreditations and Rankings:

- Dr. E. R. Aruna highlighted Vardhaman College holds accreditations from NBA and NAAC with an 'A++' grade. The college has achieved notable rankings, including:
 - NIRF Rankings
 - The World Institutions (WI) Rankings
 - The World Institutions (WI) Green Rankings
 - 26th rank in the Times All Engineering Institutes Ranking Survey 2024 out of 175 top colleges
 - 24th rank among private engineering colleges
 - 16th rank in South Zone engineering colleges
 - The Week-Hansa Research Survey rankings

Audits:

- Dr. E. R. Aruna listed out the audits that the institution undergoes internal and external audits, including AAA and Environmental Audits, ensuring compliance with quality standards.

IQAC Events: Dr. E.R. Aruna emphasized on Key events organized by IQAC include

- GURU-DAKSHTA (Faculty Development Program)
- Learner-Centered Pedagogy (Faculty Development Program)
- NAAC Sponsored Seminar
- Workshop on AQAR
- Seminar on the Elimination of Violence Against Women

Students' Feedback:

- Dr. E.R. Aruna stated a regular feedback system, which was collected from students regarding teaching-learning processes, facilities, and overall satisfaction, with measures taken to address concerns.

Incentives for Faculty and Students:

- For Faculty: Incentives for research publications and NPTEL toppers.
- For Students: Academic toppers receive cash prizes.

Student Academic Performance 2023-24:

- Out of 967 students, 825 passed, resulting in an impressive pass percentage of 83.35%.

Placement Details 2023-24:

- Out of 988 students, the college achieved an 86% placement rate, with the maximum salary reaching ₹33,87,000 CTC.

Startups: The institution currently has 15 startups under incubation and under pre-incubation.

Dr. E. R. Aruna proposed a comprehensive set of initiatives under various categories, aiming for the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to establish both long-term and short-term goals to enhance the quality of education and institutional effectiveness for the academic year 2024-25.

IQAC Quality Initiatives 2024-25

Revised Quality Benchmarks:

- Dr. Aruna presented the revised Departmental Score Card (DSC) and Performance-Based Appraisal System (PBAS) metrics, which have been updated from approximately 300 to 500 points for departments and faculties. These revisions are designed to ensure greater inclusivity and further enhance quality.

Accreditations: Dr. Aruna explained the upcoming accreditation plans and the institution's strategy for meeting the necessary criteria.

- **NBA Accreditation:** Six UG programs—CSE, IT, ECE, EEE, ME, and CSE (AI & ML)—are set for reaccreditation or fresh accreditation by 2025. The institution has fulfilled all eligibility criteria, including PhD faculty, admissions, cadre ratio, and faculty strength, aiming to secure 6 years of accreditation by 2025.

- **NAAC Accreditation:** AQAR data compilation for 2023-2024 is in progress, with submission expected by 30 November 2024. A metric-wise analysis of the last three AQARs has been completed, with identified targets for the next two years. Specific challenges have been identified for NAAC Binary Accreditation, which will be addressed across various attributes, including curriculum, faculty resources, infrastructure, financial management, teaching, governance, student outcomes, and research. She requested external members to give suggestions on "Skill Oriented Courses as per NCRF".
- **NAAC MBGLS Framework:** Under this grading system, HEIs will be rated from Level 1 to Level 5, with Levels 1 to 4 denoting "Institutions of National Excellence" and Level 5 recognizing "Institutions of Global Excellence for Multidisciplinary Research and Education." The institution is also targeting designations as an Institution of Eminence (IoE) and She has requested to advices and had a discussion on the eligibility of the same.

Road Map for Deemed-to-be-University:

Dr. Aruna summarized the key eligibility criteria for the institution to achieve Deemed-to-be-University status, including the need to be multidisciplinary, maintain valid NAAC accreditation with a minimum 3.01 CGPA for three consecutive cycles, or have two-thirds of eligible technical programs accredited by NBA for three cycles, or achieve consistent top rankings in the NIRF. The summary also included the requirements for adequate academic and physical infrastructure, statutory approvals for professional courses, a teacher-student ratio of 1:20, and a corpus fund of ₹25 Crore.

Rankings & Challenges: Dr. Aruna presented the targeted Rankings and Challenges for the institution, detailing the following

- **NIRF Ranking:** She highlighted parameter-wise challenges that need to be addressed.
- **QS-I Gauge Rating:** The institution is gearing up for participation in the QS-I Gauge Rating, with the necessary processes already in motion, including fulfilling core and advanced criteria.
- **World Institutional Ranking (MHW):** The institution also plans to participate in the World Institutional Ranking, focusing on mental health and well-being.

IQAC Events:

- Dr. Aruna outlined the planned events for the upcoming academic year, starting with a four-day National Level Seminar scheduled from July 29th to August 1st, 2024. This seminar, held in celebration of the 4th anniversary of the National Education Policy (NEP), attracted 745 participants.

Audits:

- She mentioned that external Academic and Administrative Audits for the preceding years, starting from AY2020-21 to AY2023-24, have been planned for the remaining departments.

Best Practices – 2024-2025:

- Dr. Aruna proposed new best practices for the academic year 2024-2025, emphasizing the importance of facilitating seamless transitions from the classroom to the corporate world. This initiative includes comprehensive entrepreneurial boot camps designed to equip students with essential skills and knowledge. Additionally, the proposal highlights the need for robust support for start-ups, fostering an environment that encourages innovation and entrepreneurship among students.

IQAC Team:

- Dr. Aruna, the Coordinator, introduced her team members during the meeting.

Suggestions by External Members:

External members provided valuable suggestions aimed at enhancing the effectiveness of the IQAC initiatives. Key recommendations included:

- **Prof. Prashant R. Nair** advised keeping an eye out for the upcoming NBA new accreditation manual, which will be released in October, to reference sustainability goals, green initiatives, and specific initiatives related to the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, particularly concerning the Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit (MEME) System and with 11 POs.

He suggested launching an international collaborative research consultancy called "Research Compendium," which would include student and faculty exchanges, along with joint research projects. Additionally, he recommended allocating a budget for fellowships and research scholars. He also proposed offering incentives or cash prizes for students who excel in publications, hackathons, sports, start-ups, and competitions at both national and international levels, including IEEE awards.

Furthermore, he guided us to review NASSCOM's Future Skills Prime to ensure that our college's skill-oriented courses are aligned with the National Credit Framework (NCrF) mapping, specifically to the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) only, the National Higher Education Qualifications Framework (NHEQF) only, or both NSQF and NHEQF.

Additionally, he advised focusing on multidimensional outcomes for best practices.

He also recommended using internally standardized (Customized) ERP automation for data collection.

He also suggested incorporating i20 forms, ID cards with geotagged photos, and admission letters into the process for evidence of Higher Studies of the Passed-out students.

Along with QS I-GAUGE, he proposed focusing on QS rankings, specifically targeting THE Impact Rankings, THE Sustainability Rankings, QS World, QS Asia, BRICS country Rankings, and Subject-wise rankings.

Finally, He also advised gathering feedback on yoga and cultural activities provided to students.

- **Prof. R. Nageswara Rao** suggested that open programs, such as surveys and interactions with all stakeholders, faculty, and students, should be conducted to gather ideas and address issues, which will ultimately lead to the generation of new ideas and initiatives.

He advised brainstorming strategies to attract NRI students for admissions, with a particular focus on enhancing state-of-the-art facilities for region diversity.

He also recommended conducting a faculty satisfaction survey.

Apart from Scopus and Web of Science, he emphasized the importance of focusing on UGC CARE, as NAAC accepts UGC CARE publications.

- **Mr. Jitender Singh** advised focusing on skills, the quality of education, and attracting high-quality students. He suggested conducting exit interviews to improve faculty retention. Discussions should be held with faculty members who have submitted their resignations to understand their reasons for leaving. He also advised investigating any potential integrity issues.
- **Mr. G. Naveen Kumar**, our alumnus, suggested that students utilize platforms like LinkedIn and Naukri to enhance their placement opportunities in addition to campus placements. He emphasized the importance of leveraging professional networking platforms like LinkedIn and Naukri to connect students with potential employers and expand their career opportunities.

He also advised prioritizing both salary packages and the number of successful placements to demonstrate the effectiveness of the institution's career services and the overall value of its programs.
- **Mr. Purini Suresh** advised including more student clubs. He recommended using generative AI for placement skills training. He also suggested focusing on alumni collaborations to improve the number of placements.
- **Mr. Geard Jaysingh** advised fostering an entrepreneurial mindset and equipping students with essential skills such as creativity, problem-solving, and leadership to encourage innovation and self-reliance. He also suggested cultivating a culture of accountability and responsibility among students, faculty, and staff to promote ethical conduct, ownership, and continuous improvement.
- **Student members** suggested adding extracurricular activities and providing additional training on coding skills.

Vote of Thanks:

- Dr. Aruna concluded the meeting by delivering a vote of thanks to all members present for their valuable contributions and insights. Special appreciation was extended to Dr. E.R. Aruna, IQAC Coordinator, for her leadership in presenting the quality initiatives. Gratitude was also expressed to the external members for their guidance, the faculty members for their commitment to quality education, and all attendees for their participation. The meeting ended on an optimistic note, looking forward to a productive and successful year ahead.



